**Competition Rules/Information**

1. All competitors must be of amateur status and be **under the age of 18 at the 1<sup>st</sup> January 2018** and have an active handicap.
2. Competition format 18 hole medal, maximum handicap, boys 28, girls 36. Current handicap certificates are to be shown on arrival at the registration desk situated in the Club House. Please register ½ hour before tee off time.
3. Report to starter on first tee at least 5 minutes before your start time. Failure to comply will incur a **2 shot penalty**.
4. All entries are to be accompanied by a cheque for £12.00 or (£8.00 for BGC members) made payable to Bramhall Golf Club. Entry forms available on [www.bramhallgolfclub.co.uk](http://www.bramhallgolfclub.co.uk) or [www.golfempire.co.uk](http://www.golfempire.co.uk)
5. Competitors will be advised by email their start time. Results will be posted on the club website [www.bramhallgolfclub.co.uk](http://www.bramhallgolfclub.co.uk) from 8 August.
6. If you wish to withdraw from the competition please phone the Pro Shop on 0161 439 6092, option 3.
7. Local Rules are to be found on the reverse of the score card.
8. In the event of thunder and lightning the klaxon will sound 5 blasts. Please mark your ball and immediately take shelter either in the Club House, the Halfway Lodge or any of the storm shelters on the course. The latter are to be found near the 6<sup>th</sup>, 12, 14<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup> tee. Play to resume when a further 5 blasts from the klaxon are made.
9. In the event of a tie the winner for the net categories will be by Rule as to tie using hidden holes. For the gross competition a sudden death play-off will be used starting at the first hole.
10. No caddies and no supporter to be within 25 yards of players.
11. Mobiles must be switched off on the course.
12. Recognised golf attire must be worn on the golf course. Dress code in the club house is smart casual no jeans, trainers or stocking feet. Remember to bring a pair of shoes to wear in the club house.
13. A practice round will be made available at a cost of £10.00. Accompanying adults may play at the Members guest rate.
14. On the day of the competition the Practice Ground will be open from 1100 hours. Range balls are available from the Professional at a cost £1.00 per basket.
15. Any competitor misbehaving on the practice ground, course or club house shall be barred from continuing the competition and their behaviour reported to their home club.
16. All disputes shall be settled by the committee whose decision shall be final.
17. There will be no formal presentation. Winners will be advised via email and vouchers sent through the post.
