Projects for August Renovation fortnight

- 8th hazard 100yds from the Green
 - Make the left side of this a proper pond, including 25 to 50% of the grassed area in the dip. The remaining part of the dip to be raised to the height of the fairway.
- 8th dip in front of the tee
 - Shape the banks to look more like the new pond, leaving the path as is but aiming for the water to be the same level on each side.
- 7th pond behind the green
 - Extend the pond part way down the side of the green.

Woodland Management Plan

MANAGEMENT AIMS AND OBJECTIVES

- A. Maintain and enhance the quality of the golf course
- B. Maintain and enhance the long-term landscape value of the course.
- C. Enhance the value of the course for wildlife.
- D. Ensure safety of members, guests and employees.



Woodland Management

- Overhanging Holly on corner of 7th
- Let more sunlight on to 13th back tee
- Tidy copses – between 15&16, LHS 8
- Expose more of the mature oaks
- Shape & deadwood some of the oaks – 1st & 8th
- Thin copse right of 14th green to let light through
- Plant more conifers behind 5th green
- Thin trees near pond on 10th to improve visibility

- 6th open up the pond by the green
- 7th improve the drainage
- 12th path left side of the tee
- 15th open & expand the pond on the right
- 9th improve the drainage

Look After Our Course

- Repair Pitch Marks
- Repair Your Divots – including on the Practice Ground
- Use the Divot Bags
- Rake bunkers & push sand to the middle
- Minimise walking & standing right by the hole
- Keep Trolleys
 - Outside of greenside bunkers & off the fringe
 - Off the Tees
- Use the Paths, especially in winter
- Winter Wheels on Electric Trolleys or Carry in Winter
- Support Working Parties
