Bar and clubhouse Opening times

As of Monday 12 Sept and until further notice the bar will be open the following times each week:

Heating and Hot water

Since our existing boilers were condemned in late July we have installed a new boiler and a larger and more powerful hot water cylinder for the kitchen, gent's toilets and showers. During the installation leaks on the existing system were found but these have now been fixed. We also found the gas pressure at the boiler was less than half of what it needs to be. This also helps to explain why the old heating system never worked properly.



We are waiting for prices to install a new gas pipe from the meter in the kitchen yard. Once we have agreed the price and route, either under the clubhouse or in a trench across the car park, we will install the new pipe as quickly as possible.

In the interim, as it is dangerous to operate the boiler at less than the recommended gas pressure, I apologise but it might be a little chilly at times in the clubhouse and unless you are made of strong stuff a cold shower in the gents is not recommended. The ladies are on a separate system and so there should be no impact albeit we will continue to try and reduce the hot water temperature to a more comfortable level.

Utility Prices

We are all aware of increasing utility prices especially gas and electric. Last year we fixed our gas price for 3 years from 1 Dec 2017 and today we have done the same for our electricity costs. Unfortunately, today's power price is an increase of nearly 7% on last year's price but fixed for three years. The expert advice we took indicated that power prices will continue to increase above this rate and protects the club against the effect the Brexit process is having and will continue to cause to currency and energy prices.
